


Friends of Calligraphy is pleased to present

**John Prestianni** will discuss and present his work as a calligrapher and lettering artist over more than two decades, as well as his experience as the Editor of Friends of Calligraphy's journal *Alphabet*. John Prestianni is a longtime member of the Friends of Calligraphy. He was the founding editor of *Alphabet*, *The Journal of the Friends of Calligraphy*, and *Calligraphic Type Design in the Digital Age*, for FOC's Zapfest: An Exhibition in Honor of the Contributions of Hermann and Gudrun Zapf. He has written extensively on calligraphy, typography and the book arts. Originally trained as a calligrapher, he produced hand lettering for a wide variety of commercial purposes and worked for many years as a designer of books and other publications.
